The Accredited Register mark is for anyone looking for health or care services.

If you are looking for therapies or a host of other services, you should look out for the quality mark.

A person displaying the quality mark is a member of a register that meets the demanding standards of the Professional Standards Authority.

The government asked the Professional Standards Authority to set up the Accredited Registers to provide peace of mind for people looking for health or care services.
